I founded and built Handheld Gazette, an editorial site entirely created and run by AI to review commercial handheld game releases across platforms like Game Boy, GBC, GBA, and PICO-8. Since January 2026, I've developed and maintain a fully automated, agent-driven publication pipeline that processes new game discoveries, generates high-quality reviews, handles deployments, rotates weekly featured content, and conducts quality audits all operating on a strict weekly cron schedule. The platform has published over 266 game reviews and documented 20 hardware items, with 138 commits to its repository.

The system uses a five-agent architecture orchestrated for editorial quality and consistency: one agent discovers new games, another generates and refines reviews, a third manages deployments, a fourth handles the weekly featured game rotation, and a fifth performs continuous quality and link audits. This isn't just AI-generated text it's a robust pipeline with built-in editorial controls and autonomous publishing capabilities.

Technically, the site runs as a static generation workflow with multi-agent orchestration, cron-based triggers, and rigorous quality assurance checks at each stage. The implementation leverages modern tools and practices to ensure reliability, quality, and scalability in an entirely AI-driven publishing environment.

As the Founder & Product Lead of SmartCVWriter, I am building smartcvwriter.com an agentic CV optimization platform designed to generate AI-ready CVs from diverse inputs.

The product accepts voice recordings, PDF imports, data dumps and API sources; processes them using AWS Transcribe for transcription, and leverages Amazon Bedrock to create AI-optimized summaries.

The end result is a polished, exportable CV profile available in both PDF and structured formats.

The architecture is entirely AWS-native, utilizing services such as Cognito for authentication, DynamoDB for storage, Lambda for serverless compute, and S3 paired with CloudFront for hosting.

We incorporate multi-source data merging from platforms like Notion and LinkedIn. Additionally, I am developing an MCP/API offering tailored for recruiters.

Notably, the product development process itself is built with an agile team of AI agents. We utilize Claude Code via ACP for feature implementation, and an OpenClaw agent manages deployment and testing.

This makes SmartCVWriter not only a product focused on AI but also one that is actively built leveraging AI to today's fullest capabilities.

Founder & Product Lead InsightLab.be (2025 - Present)

I founded InsightLab.be as a digital health platform focused on empowering patients with clear, AI-driven interpretations of their medical test results. This lab serves as the primary research and product base for all my AI work. I built the original InsightLab product with extensive assistance from OpenAI Codex, creating a blood test analysis platform where users upload PDF blood test results, and the system generates personalized health reports.

I designed a novel privacy architecture where reports are encrypted server-side with single-use passwords, with decryption happening entirely client-side in the user's browser, ensuring the server never accesses decrypted data.

In 2026, I rebuilt the platform as blood.insightlab.be using a modern AWS stack, including Amazon Bedrock for AI analysis, AWS Lambda for serverless compute, Svelte 5 for the frontend, S3 for storage, and CloudFront for CDN.

The platform now uses AI to interpret medical blood test results and generate personalized health reports for patients, facilitating informed conversations between patients and healthcare professionals. The lab continues to be the foundation for all AI research, generating insights that inform subsequent AI products like CV Writer, Handheld Gazette, and ScrumDark.

Storyteller TeamPlay Lab (2025 - Present)

As the Storyteller at TeamPlay Lab, I specialize in using narrative-driven, experiential learning to enhance team performance and collaboration. My approach centers around designing and facilitating engaging, game-based learning experiences that foster trust, communication, and creative problem-solving among team members. By leveraging social deduction games like Blood on the Clocktower, I create immersive scenarios that mirror real-world challenges, enabling participants to practice conflict resolution, decision-making, and strategic thinking in a safe, memorable environment.

This position requires a deep understanding of group dynamics and psychological safety, ensuring that participants not only learn from the experience but also feel comfortable expressing ideas and perspectives. My work impacts both individual team members and entire organizations by building stronger, more cohesive teams capable of tackling complex problems together. The role blends creativity, facilitation skills, and an intuitive grasp of human behavior to turn abstract concepts into tangible, actionable insights.

I employ a participant-centered approach, tailoring experiences to the specific needs and goals of each team. Whether working with cross-functional corporate teams or smaller project groups, the core objective remains the same: to use storytelling and play to unlock potential, improve performance, and cultivate a culture of continuous learning and adaptability.

Agile Coach CureVac (2025 - 2026)

At CureVac, I was brought in to help teams developing personalized cancer vaccines within a strict GxP-regulated biotech environment. My focus was on transforming the organization from a frustrated, stagnant state into a streamlined, high-performance group. I achieved this by restructuring the team into two specialized units: one dedicated to rapid scientific exploration and the other to stable cloud industrialization. This 'Pragmatic Lean' model moved away from rigid Agile dogma, establishing a Minimal Viable Agile framework that respected both the need for biotech innovation and engineering rigor.

I facilitated the integration of AI-assisted workflows into this highly regulated pharma setting. This involved a comprehensive evaluation of all available corporate AI tools, exposing significant gaps between security restrictions and actual employee needs. The team leveraged private LLMs for reporting and automation, integrated GitHub Copilot into development workflows, and evaluated tools like Atlassian Confluence Rovo AI.

My role was deliberately focused on the 'human stack' the interpersonal dynamics where AI couldn't reach. I identified and mediated toxic patterns, built psychological safety, and facilitated honest communication across teams and sites. This people-centered approach, combined with technical implementation, transformed the team into a cohesive, high-performing unit capable of sustainable innovation within regulatory constraints.

Agile Expert for Operational Excellence Proximus (July 2024 - January 2025)

Technologies: Jira, Office Suite, agile reporting, AI-assisted workflow analysis

I was brought in to help Proximus' sales management teams adopt agile principles and improve operational efficiency. My focus was on establishing consistent rhythms and simplifying reporting processes using the tools already familiar to the team, rather than imposing new systems. This was a unique challenge, as it involved introducing agility into a traditional office environment without the usual IT tooling support. I worked closely with product owners and enablement teams to refine their workflows and systems, helping them eliminate bottlenecks and unnecessary complexity. The engagement required a deep understanding of both agile methodologies and the specific cultural and procedural constraints of a large, established organization. By fostering adaptability and continuous improvement, I helped the teams transition towards more responsive and effective ways of working.

Agile Expert for the Flanders Sales Teams Proximus (February 2024 - July 2024)

Technologies: WSJF, Agile methodologies, team motivation, AI tooling evaluation for non-IT teams

I was brought in to inject agility into the Flanders Sales teams at Proximus, a group that shared common activities but lacked a unified goal, where traditional Scrum practices had fallen short. My focus was on fostering team spirit, tackling skill gaps, and addressing WSJF priority impediments, guiding the teams toward their eventual integration into the Proximus NXT IT group. I emphasized the core principles of Agile adaptability, collaboration, and continuous improvement embedding them into the team's culture. This involved evaluating AI tools for sales reporting and impediment tracking, helping to modernise processes and improve team performance through practical, principle-driven agility rather than rigid methodology. The role required balancing human dynamics with technical possibilities, ensuring that agility served the team's real needs rather than conforming to textbook practices.

Co-Founder & CTO Social Paragraph (2021 - 2022)

Technologies: OpenAI API (early access), content automation, browser plugin, social media API

As Co-Founder and Tech Lead of Social Paragraph from September 2021 to December 2022, I spearheaded the development of a pioneering content automation platform designed for high-volume social media publishing. This role placed me among the earliest external developers to gain access to the OpenAI API through direct engagement with OpenAI's leadership. Our platform aimed to leverage AI-generated content for direct social media integration but pivoted following critical viability testing.

During testing, we encountered significant challenges with AI-generated content reliability, specifically the issue of hallucinations fabricated information that is difficult to detect at scale. A notable incident involved an AI-generated game review containing an undetected fabricated accolade, which took over 20 minutes of manual review to identify. This revealed fundamental limitations in early AI models, particularly their lack of retrieval or grounding mechanisms, and led to the abandonment of AI-generated content in favor of classic human-driven processes.

The platform itself was developed using classic web technologies, including a browser plugin for content automation and integration with social media APIs. This experience underscored critical lessons about data validity in AI applications, influencing subsequent approaches to AI deployment in both enterprise and product development contexts.

Head of Digital Innovation Savion Ray (2022 - 2022)

At Savion Ray, I was brought in to elevate the agency's digital offerings by introducing cutting-edge web techniques and maturing their innovation capabilities. The agency served a diverse client base with varying web quality standards, ranging from basic HTML sites to cinematic, data-driven productions. My focus was on ensuring clients received state-of-the-art websites, moving beyond legacy practices. I introduced then advanced cinematic web techniques such as parallax scrolling, video insights, and interactive maps that respond to user scroll behavior. Additionally, I worked on maturing their A/B testing capabilities by evaluating various platforms and transitioning clients to more data-driven testing methodologies.

This role required a blend of technical expertise and strategic thinking to bring innovation into the agency's client delivery processes, ensuring that their digital outputs were not only visually impressive but also functionally superior and aligned with modern web standards.

Product Owner. Privacy Management & GDPR Proximus (Dec 2020 - May 2022)

Technologies: Java, SaaS, LDAP, JBoss

I was tasked with running product ownership for the Privacy Management API and the GDPR API at Proximus from December 2020 to May 2022.

I led a newly hand-picked team that we grew from a handful of Java developers to twelve T-profile team members by the time I handed it over. My role involved managing these critical business applications, ensuring they maintained 99.9% uptime despite the challenges posed by the large Proximus landscape.

I successfully delivered several iterations of both APIs and oversaw a full reimplementation that moved us away from LDAP and JBoss.

The position required a strong focus on keeping production systems running smoothly through various challenges and war rooms, which provided me with valuable experience in maintaining high availability in a complex environment.

The role was executed within a SaaS-style environment, where I was responsible for guiding the product vision and ensuring alignment with business needs while navigating the intricacies of large-scale enterprise systems.

Agile coach & Scrum master for IAM Proximus (2019 - 2025)

Technologies: Java, GDPR, IAM, SaaS, SaaS, Jira, Confluence

From July 2019 to January 2024, I served as Agile Coach and Scrum Master for the IAM (Identity and Access Management) domain at Proximus. My primary responsibility was to restore and sustain effective agile practices within a large SaaS-like structure of over 40 developers, testers, and product owners who had become disorganized and ineffective due to a lack of dedicated Scrum Master leadership. I began by establishing visibility and transparency using the existing tooling (Jira, Confluence), which allowed us to interface effectively with other teams and deliver successfully. I introduced best practices for leveraging internal tools fully and led the Community of Practice (CoP) to promote these practices across the organization.

To address planning and predictability issues, I reshaped the team into four distinct squads, each with its own Product Owner, and acted as Scrum Master to support their needs. This restructuring, combined with my coaching, helped create a stable and predictable delivery rhythm. We focused on stability, healthy metrics, single source of truth cross teams, .. When the COVID-19 lockdown forced an abrupt transition to fully remote work, we were ready. I ensured business continuity without disrupting workflows or hiring processes, demonstrating adaptability and resilience.

My approach emphasizes positivity, pragmatism, and sustained energy to tackle each challenge systematically. By fostering an environment of psychological safety and clear communication, I enabled teams to navigate complexities and deliver consistently. This role demanded not just technical knowledge but also strong interpersonal skills to mediate conflicts, align stakeholders, and maintain team morale throughout significant organizational changes.

Scrum Masters CoP Lead Belfius (Apr 2019 - Jun 2019)

I led the fledgling Scrum Masters Community of Practice at Belfius, working to unify and strengthen the community's knowledge sharing and collaboration across different domains within the bank. In this three-month role, I focused on building cohesion among Scrum Masters, facilitating knowledge exchange, and supporting continuous learning. The initiative aimed to create a sustainable framework for shared insights and best practices, helping Scrum Masters better support their teams and drive agility across Belfius. My work emphasized creating an environment where experiences could be openly shared, challenges addressed collectively, and agile practices deepened through peer interaction.

Project Lead & Solution Designer Belfius (2017 - 2018)

At Belfius, I served as Project Lead and Solution Designer from December 2017 to October 2018, steering several significant internal projects. My role involved bridging traditional, challenging business stakeholders with agile development teams, ensuring smooth transitions and effective communication across Prince2 and Scrum methodologies. I led projects that required careful stakeholder management, balancing old-fashioned expectations with modern agile practices. This position demanded a pragmatic approach to integrating diverse methodologies, fostering collaboration, and delivering solutions that met both business needs and technical standards. My work focused on guiding teams through complex transitions, ensuring project success through strategic leadership and adaptive problem-solving.

Trainer Gamified (2016 - 2019)

From April 2016 to October 2019, I worked as a Trainer at Gamified, hosting business workshops designed to make complex information more digestible for teams. My role involved delivering immersive, interactive sessions that helped participants grasp intricate concepts through engaging, scenario-based learning. I crafted and facilitated curriculum around various topics, adapting content to the specific needs and challenges faced by each participating team. The format was a full-course immersive experience over the span of one workshop, ensuring participants left with practical knowledge they could immediately apply. My approach focused on clarity, collaboration, and translating complexity into actionable insights, supporting clients in achieving their learning and development objectives.

Project Manager Chancellery of the Prime Minister of Belgium (2016 - 2017)

I was brought in to revitalize a long-struggling project with another government institution that had a troubled history and a complex landscape of stakeholders with deep professional and philosophical divides.

My mandate was to restore effective project management practices and get the work back onto solid Prince2 foundations. The challenge was substantial not only was the project technically demanding, but it also required navigating intense human dynamics and reconciling conflicting viewpoints across many actors. I worked closely with all parties to re-establish clear governance, realign processes, and rebuild trust, focusing on transparency, structured milestones, and consistent communication.

Through this effort, we were able to stabilize the project, re-establish predictable delivery rhythms, and create a more collaborative environment that allowed the team to move forward with renewed focus and confidence.

Co-Founder Gent Lean Coffee (2016 - 2022)

As Co-Founder of Gent Lean Coffee from 2016, I established and led a cross-functional meetup group in Gent focused on practical knowledge exchange and problem-solving among professionals.

Inspired by Lean Coffee Belgium and in the footsteps of Jim Benson and Jeremy Lightsmith in the Seattle of 2009. We facilitated learning through shared experiences, fostering an environment where participants could discuss challenges and ideas in an open, collaborative setting.

The role required strong organizational skills to coordinate meetings, manage stakeholder and community expectations, and ensure the group remained valuable and engaging over nearly eight years. This position deepened my abilities in facilitation, conflict mediation, and community building, complementing my broader experience in agile practices and team leadership.

Managing Partner & CTO schip.gent (2016 - 2022)

At schip.gent, our self-funded startup studio, I co-founded and ran a series of lean digital ventures alongside one or two trusted partners. Together, we explored, shaped, and incubated a portfolio of early-stage projects validating ideas quickly, building MVPs, and spinning out the most promising as standalone businesses.

As co-founder and hands-on CTO, I led product design, prototyping, and technical execution. I worked across the full lifecycle from napkin sketch to working software and internal launch often building early versions myself or with lean, high-trust teams. We embraced a "fail early, fail well" mindset and built everything without external funding.

Our diverse projects included: - Social Paragraph content automation platform and browser plugin - StreetCharges modular, hardware-enabled street-level charging prototype - Samay a virtual assistant for task delegation and scheduling - Payables early-stage fintech play around structured B2B payments - Gewoon Wijn wine discovery concept for retail and e-commerce - Loud Equity & Display experiments in visibility, social proof, and smart display tech

Each venture brought its own technical and business complexity, and required fast thinking, strategic prioritization, and continuous iteration. We ran multiple experiments in parallel from AI tooling to hardware to B2C platforms combining creativity with grounded execution.

This chapter sharpened my instincts as a product strategist and builder, deepened my understanding of startup mechanics, and gave me hands-on experience turning fragile ideas into launchable products under real-world constraints.

Agile Cloud Consultant. Architect, Infra team lead Agentschap Wegen & Verkeer (2014 - 2016)

Technologies: Java, DevOps, CI/CD, Microservices

I was brought in to transition the internal IT infrastructure from a bare-metal, waterfall-based setup to a modern agile cloud environment.

The project involved introducing DevOps practices, implementing continuous integration and deployment pipelines, and preparing the ground for a move to microservices. The final infrastructure comprised around 30 applications built on a mix of technologies including Java, PHP, and Ruby on Rails, running on Amazon Cloud within the Flemish government context.

I designed and implemented a cloud architecture featuring strictly separated development, testing, and production environments, with a robust framework for automated, parameter-driven server provisioning. This included setting up Confluence and Jira for project management, GitLab for version control and CI/CD orchestration, and Nexus for artifact management, all while maintaining high security standards and minimizing vendor lock-in.

The solution delivered a flexible, reproducible environment that met strict performance and uptime requirements.

After 20 months of focused work, I handed over the fully operational cloud infrastructure to an internal team manager who continues to run it today.

Communications Director JCI Aalst (2014 - 2015)

As Communications Director at JCI Aalst from July 2014 to July 2015, I managed all aspects of communication for the organization. This role involved facilitating effective communication channels for board members, overseeing the editorial content of two magazines, and maintaining both internal and external brand image.

My responsibilities included developing and implementing communication plans, handling public relations, and coordinating events to enhance JCI Aalst's visibility and engagement within the community.
